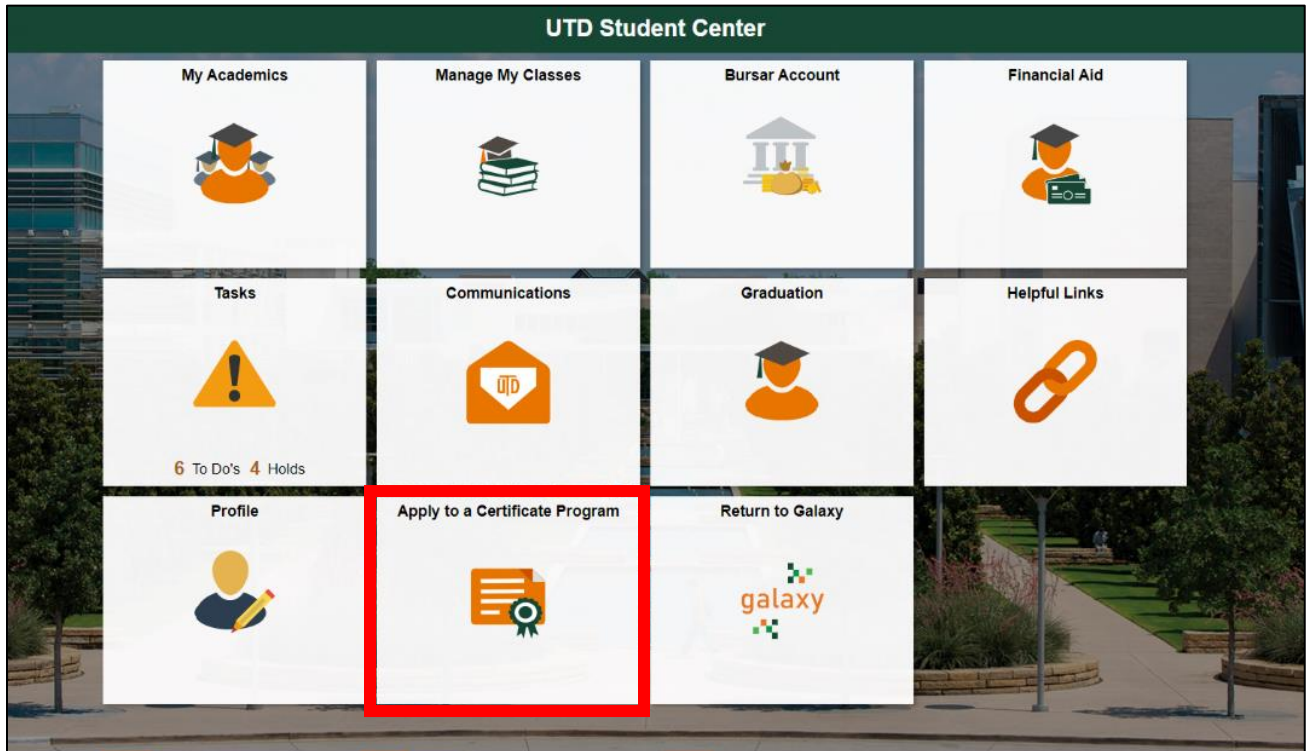


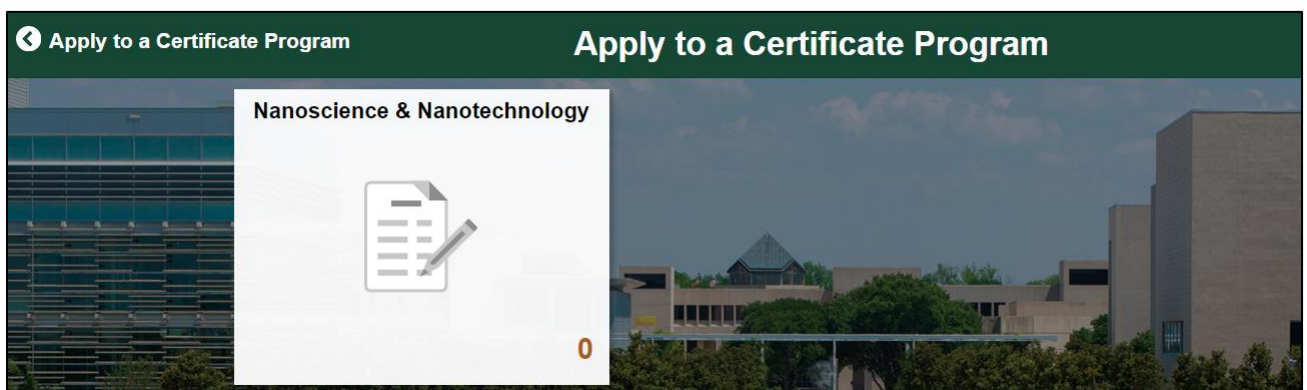
# How to Apply to the Certificate in Nanoscience and Nanotechnology

Students can access and submit their application by following these steps:

1. Go to UTD Student Center
2. Click Apply to a Certificate Program:



3. Select the program you wish to apply to:



4. Fill out your UTD-ID and Desired Start Term:

5. Next, confirm you are not graduating this summer. Once you do, the Next button will appear. Click the Next button:

6. Fill out all of the answers, and click Save Answers. Then click the Next button:

7. Click Submit. Then you will be taken back to your Academic History.
